| Program | Description |
|---------------------------------------|--|
| ACE Program (IPSF) | Help coordinate the after school enrichment opportunities offered by IPSF. Each semester, students participate through ACE in science, math, language, fine arts, technology, and much more. By offering classes in areas not available during school hours, IPSF's ACE Program helps to greatly enrich the diversity of educational experiences available to our kids. |
| Assemblies | Work with staff to identify and coordinate fun student assemblies throughout the year. Work with school staff and assembly vendor to set up calendar and notify teachers. |
| Community Outreach | Help plan and organize community outreach events (Grizzly Gratitude) such as various drives (candy, food, jacket). |
| Family Fun Nights | Plan and coordinate various evening family activities on a regular basis throughout the school year. Events may include Movie Night, Game Night, Year End Celebration, Father/Daughter dance, Mother/Son event, to name a few. |
| Hospitality/Bakers | Provide baked goods and other hospitality services for PTA meetings, Back-to-School breakfast, bake sales, teacher treats, and other special occasion. This committee is instrumental in making all families feel welcome at Portola Springs Elementary! |
| Jog-A-Thon | Help plan, organize and prepare for the annual Grizzly Fun Run, which is our biggest fundraiser in the Spring. |
| Guys Stuff | Help organize, publicize and prepare annual 6 th grade boys' events as part of the health education program. Volunteers are generally parents of 6 th grade boys, but not required. |
| Membership & Pledge Donation Drive | This committee handles the PTA membership and pledge donation drive at the beginning of the year. We are striving for 100% membership! |
| Mother Daughter Tea | Help organize, publicize and prepare annual 5 th grade girls' event as part of the health education program. Volunteers are generally parents of 5 th grade girls, but not required. |
| Newsletter, Social Media & Website | Work with the PTA Board to send periodic updates of school events, notices and announcements via email blasts, Facebook page, and website. |
| Red Ribbon Week | Organize and plan daily activities and events around annual theme. |
| Reflections Program | Distribute flyers, collect and categorize art, coordinate judging. Help set up display of art work submitted. |
| Shop & Earn & Dining-Outs | Help grow our "free money" donations from parent shopping through parent communications and school contests and promotions (Box Tops, Ralphs, Amazon, Communities for Cause, etc). Help plan, organize, and publicize fun dining out nights at various restaurants as a fundraiser. |
| Pacers Running Club | The Portola Pacers is a training and racing program for students who attend Portola Springs Elementary $(1^{st} - 6^{th})$. The club meets once a week to train 10 weeks prior to the Kids Run OC Race generally held at the end of April or early May. |
| Silent Auction | Help plan, organize, and execute silent auction. |
| Spirit Wear | Help take and distribute orders for Portola Springs logo items for school spirit occasions. We sell high quality t-shirts, sweatshirts, and other apparel with our school colors and logo. |
