Planning to Volunteer On Campus?

Parents interested in volunteering at school must complete an **online volunteer application** at the beginning of **each school year.** Follow the steps below to become an approved volunteer.

- 1. Fill out the online volunteer application.
- 2. If you are a first-time volunteer, you will need to present your photo ID at the front office on your first day volunteering to Mrs. Jew.

If you are a returning volunteer, your volunteer profile will be activated, and you will not need to present your ID the first day you return to volunteer.

3. Once the screening process is complete, you will be an approved volunteer through the end of this school year.
