Reflections: Show Your Voice



The National PTA organizes an annual **Reflections contest** for Pre-K through Grade 12 students. [The Reflections program](#) provides opportunities for recognition and access to the arts which boost student confidence and success in the arts and in life. Each year, over 300,000 students create original works of art in response to a student-selected theme. This year's theme is: Show Your Voice. The program commences on August 30th.

Volunteer Opportunities

Reflections Chair (4-6 hours of total time commitment)

- Organize the submission and judging of student art work. Submissions will be submitted online.
- Coordinate judges and gather judge inputs to identify the finalist(s).
- Submit finalist artwork to district judging.

3-4 Judges (1-2 hours of total time commitment)

- When submissions are finalized, leveraging a standardized scoresheet, you will review student art work and provide scoring to determine the finalist(s) that are submitted from our school up to the national competition.

One of the biggest events that our students look forward to is **Trunk or Treat**. Families decorate their vehicles and pass out candy. In addition, we have special guest stars, food trucks and other goodies to make this a fun-filled family event.

Volunteer Opportunities

Co-Chair (15-20 total hours of time commitment)

- Assist the Chair in organizing the various needs of this event.
- Note: It is the hope that this individual will Chair the event next year and learn the ropes this year with our experienced Chairperson.

Vendor Coordinator (3-4 hours of total time commitment)

- Assist in locating available vendors to participate in our event.

Sponsorship Coordinator (3-4 hours of total time commitment)

- Assist in finding donations, organizations or businesses that would like to participate/ sponsor our event.

5 "Day Of" Volunteers (1.5 hour shift at the event)

- During the event, we'll need parents to help with logistics and boothing to run the event smoothly.


Trunk or Treat Event Evening of Oct 28th
